Signs should be in place for the new access track after Parks Vic have completed the track work, which is expected to occur by the end of March. Since the office is shut on the weekends the Ranger has agreed to place a copy of the map in the parks office window for those that can't obtain the map from the web-site.

The car park for the access point is actually between the rail crossing and the bridge. It's a little parking bay on the right as you approach the trestle bridge. DSE crews have been doing some work on the trail so hopefully the start is now pretty well defined. Markers (pink/red ribbons tied to the trees) should define the less obvious sections. This new trail follows an old railway worker trail part way down the first gully then follows the creek bed before heading up a ridge and following a spur into the trail on the other side of the fence.
